

SADC CLIMATE SERVICES CENTRE (CSC) HEAVY RAINFALL ADVISORY

FORECAST PERIOD: 25 TO 31 DECEMBER 2019

HIGHLIGHTS

HEADLINE: The SADC CSC is forecasting a likelihood of rainfall amounts

exceeding 50mm in 24 hours in some parts of the SADC region during

the period 25 to 31 December 2019.




Figure 1: SADC Region's heavy rainfall advisory for the period 25 – 31 December 2019

North eastern and western Angola, western and southern Botswana, Comoros, central and eastern Democratic Republic of Congo, Lesotho, northern Mozambique, north and central Madagascar, Mauritius, most of United Republic of Tanzania, central parts of South Africa and northern Zambia have a high probability to receive heavy rainfall above 50mm in a 24 hour period (Figure 1) from 25 to 31 December 2019. These rains are likely to result in localized flooding in certain areas.
