SEASONAL OUTLOOK FOR JUNE-JULY-AUGUST 2019

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SUMMARY OF THE JUNE-JULY-AUGUST 2019 SEASONAL OUTLOOK

The bulk of the Southern African Development Community (SADC) is expected to receive normal to below-normal rainfall with an exception of the northern half of the Democratic Republic of Congo, extreme northern and coastal areas of Tanzania, northern Madagascar, Mauritius, Comoros and Seychelles where normal to above normal rainfall is expected.

Both maximum and minimum temperatures are expected to largely be normal to below normal in the southern and northern parts of the contiguous SADC region. The bulk of the central areas of the region will experience normal to above normal temperatures during the June-July-August 2019 period.




Figure 1: Rainfall outlook for the June-July-August 2019 period

Zone 1: Northern Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC):

Increased chance for normal to above-normal rainfall

Zone 2: Northern Tanzania:

Increased chance for normal to above-normal rainfall

Zone 3: Southern DRC, north-western Tanzania, Angola, Zambia, Malawi, central and northern Mozambique, Namibia, northern Botswana, Zimbabwe and northeastern South Africa.

Increased chance for normal to below-normal rainfall

Zone 4: Southern Namibia, southern Botswana, bulk of South Africa,

Increased chance for normal to below-normal rainfall

Zone 5: Northern Madagascar

Increased chance for normal to above-normal rainfall

Zone 6: Central Madagascar

Increased chance for normal to below-normal rainfall

Zone 7: Southern Madagascar

Increased chance for normal to below-normal rainfall

Zone 8: Mauritius

Increased chance for normal to above-normal rainfall

Zone 9: Comoros

Increased chance for normal to above-normal rainfall

Zone 10: Seychelles

Increased chance for normal to above-normal rainfall




Figure 2: Minimum temperature outlook for the June-July-August 2019 period

Zone 1: North-western of Angola, Bulk of Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC):

Increased chance for normal to below-normal minimum temperatures

Zone 2: Eastern half of Angola, northern Botswana, south-eastern DRC, Malawi, most of Mozambique, Namibia, Tanzania, Zambia and most of Zimbabwe:

Increased chance for normal to above-normal minimum temperatures Zone 3: Southern Botswana, Eswatini, Lesotho, southern Mozambique, most of Namibia, South Africa and Zimbabwe.

Increased chance for normal to below-normal minimum temperatures
Zone 4: Northern Madagascar

Increased chance for normal to above-normal minimum temperatures Zone 5: Southern Madagascar

Increased chance for normal to above-normal minimum temperatures
Zone 6: Mauritius

Increased chance for normal to above-normal minimum temperatures
Zone 7: Comoros
